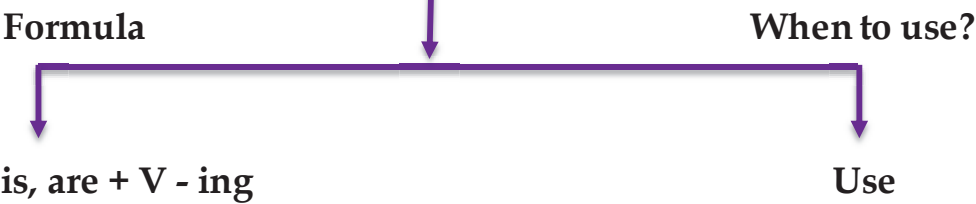


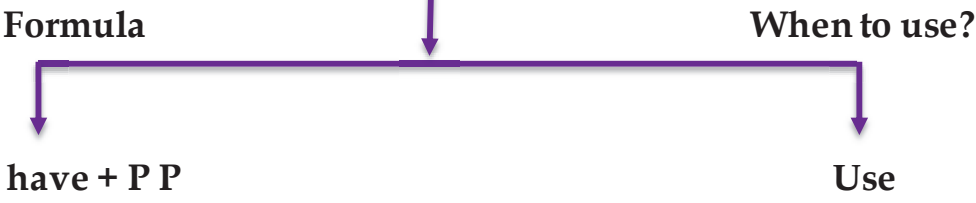
Present Tense

 2. Why are you sobbing?
 3. See, the boys are playing there?
 4. Who is be fooling us?
 5. I am plucking the flowers.

To express an action going on
 At the speaking or in front
 Of our eyes.

Present Tense
Present Perfect Tense



- Ex.** 1. They have come just now.
 2. Recently they have come here.
 3. The train has just arrived.
 4. Why have you come here?
 5. Who has told you?

To express an action recently
 Finished.
