Formula

When to use?

S + had + been + V - ing

Use

- Ex.** 1. I had been reading for two hours.
2. She had been crying for two days.
3. I had been asking for three days.
4. She had been studying for ten hours.

To express an action started in
Past at a particular time and
Upto a particular time the action
had been going on.

Future Tense

Simple Future Tense

Formula

When to use?

S + Will / shall + V1

Use

- Ex.** 1. I will come tomorrow.
2. I will ask doubts.
3. She will be happy.
4. They will help me.
5. I shall do it.
6. They will follow me.

To express future action or an
action that is about to take place.
